This project offers a new field of learning that focuses on social inclusion, our unique approach empowers individuals to become effective advocates for sustainability and uncover innovative solutions to tackle environmental challenges.


PARTNERS WILL MEET AGAIN IN GREECE, 14 - 16 June 2023

The team will be meeting in Greece this June, to have an exciting day of learning. It is a valuable opportunity to put our resources to the test, in real communities striving to be climate champions.

On day one, we will cover workshops that explore the course on empowering biodiversity and climate change community champions. These workshops will focus on understanding the curriculum and putting open educational resources (OERs) into practice.

On day two, we'll visit communities and educators with successful biodiversity and climate action practices, and hold sustainability workshops on "Communities in Action." The workshops will feature a compendium of 30 inspiring and transferable projects.

The final day provides comprehensive training on the practical Theory of Change Toolkit for Communities, including role-plays, case studies, and evaluation exercises to apply to real-life scenarios for climate action and biodiversity projects.



The Recommendations and Report of Citizens' Assembly on Biodiversity Loss was launched in Dublin this April, marking a historic moment as the first-ever national citizens' assembly dedicated to biodiversity loss worldwide.

The report, produced after seven meetings of the Assembly between May 2022 and January 2023, includes over 150 recommendations that could significantly transform Ireland's relationship with the natural environment.

The launch of the report is a significant milestone in Ireland's efforts to address the biodiversity crisis.

The report's recommendations, agreed upon by all 99 members of the Assembly, include 73 highlevel recommendations and 86 sector-specific actions and priorities. It covers a wide range of topics related to biodiversity loss and could serve as a blueprint for other countries seeking to address this crucial issue.

EARTH DAY 2023

Officially Earth Day was just last month, but really every day is Earth Day.

This year will mark the 53rd anniversary of the annual event. Earth Day is a global event that brings together people from around the world to celebrate the planet and to raise awareness about the importance of protecting it.

BIODIVERISTY FOR THE FAMILY

Biodiversity is not just an important concept for scientists and environmentalists, it's something that can be enjoyed by all the family.

When we talk about biodiversity, we mean all the different living things that inhabit the planet - from plants and animals to insects and fungi.

By getting out into nature and exploring the world around us, we can experience the incredible diversity of life on Earth. Take a walk in a park, forest, or nature reserve and look for different types of birds, butterflies, and wildflowers.

As mentioned in *The Bee Sanctuary of Ireland* case study in our Compendium. 'Habitat loss, non-native species, and the use of herbicides and pesticides in agriculture has led to a 76% decline in flying insect populations by mass in Europe between 1991 and 2018.' Here are a few things we can do to help the critters thrive again.

Backyard Biodiversity:

Here you can find some activities and tips on what you can do to help promote biodiversity in your own backyard or even just on your balcony or windowsill. Click on the icons below to have a look at some of the amazing resources from Tree Tools for Schools by the Woodland Trust, they have a range of activities for all the family from minibeast hunts to how to make a simple bird feeder.

Bug Hotels - Are a great way to promote an create an ecosystem of Biodiversity. All you need is some old bits of wood and some foliage and the wildlife will come flocking in. Everyday you'll be able to see different species and critters create a life for themselves in something you did.

No cut areas - If you have a backyard with some grass and flowers growing then you could dedicate an area that won't be cut down in the monthly lawn mowing session. Create a buzz and a hive of activity for all the wildlife to enjoy, from bugs, bees, birds, mammals.











On March 28th our Bulgarian partner Europerspectives Foundation (EPF) presented the Climate Champions project to entrepreneurs and SMEs, owners and managers, interested in upskilling on the topic of climate change, sustainability and culture of change to apply the knowledge into practice.

The main topic of the event was turning climate changes into business opportunities, sustainable innovation, and culture of change, and empowering eco behaviour of business to fight climate change. Vihra Andonova from EPF shared with the audience good practices from the Compendium developed under the project and provided information about the other two project results - Theory of Change and Climate Change Community Champions course.

The main goal of this dissemination action was to raise discussion about the growing role of the circular business model to combat climate change. Trainers and trainees shared knowledge and experience and the outcome was better understanding of climate change, SDGs and how to reach their targets, and culture of change.


